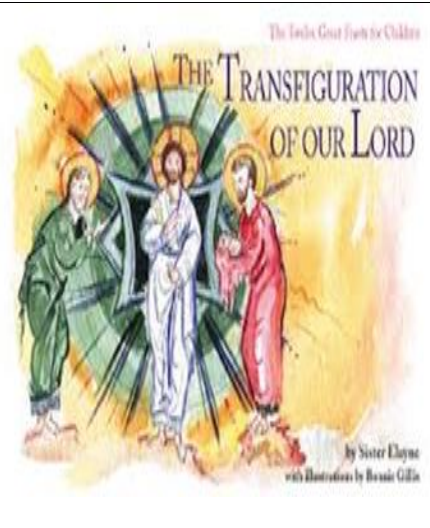

Congratulations to the children from Stella Maris and St. Martin's schools and the children from Preca House who are making their First Eucharist this week.



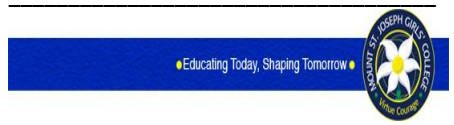

TRANSFIGURATION REFLECTION

Today's mountain walk was a huge experience for the three who would always be with Him. They saw Jesus in His glory. Somehow they knew the real identity of Jesus-beloved son of the Father: more to him than meets the eye. When we climb a mountain we see new views - the city from a new vantage point, beauty we have never seen before. We need times to climb mountains and get away from the ordinary. Like Jesus we need places where we hear the words-*you are my son, daughter and the beloved*. We know if we believe that, our lives will be challenged. Whenever we climb the mountain of the Lord or make any journey with Him, we are changed. As every mountain is different, every moment with the Lord is well worthwhile! Pope Francis says: "we now return home with a good seed: the seed of the Word of God." "The Lord will send rain and that seed will grow. It will grow and it will bear fruit. We thank the Lord for the seed and for the rain that he will send us, but we also want to thank the sower because you were the sower and you know how to do it."
